In the Australian Child Wellbeing Project (ACWP), children's perspectives were used to develop Australia's first major nationally representative and internationally comparable survey of wellbeing among children aged 8-14 years. The project is conducted by a team of researchers at Flinders University of South Australia, the University of New South Wales and the Australian Council for Educational Research. It is funded by the Australian Research Council through a Linkage Grant, and supported by various government and other Partner Organisations.

As results of the national survey will be available only in 2015, this presentation focuses on various aspects of the questionnaire development, including:

- questionnaire framework
- item and scale development
- cognitive interviews
- field trial
- ethics applications
- survey marketing
- online questionnaire implementation
