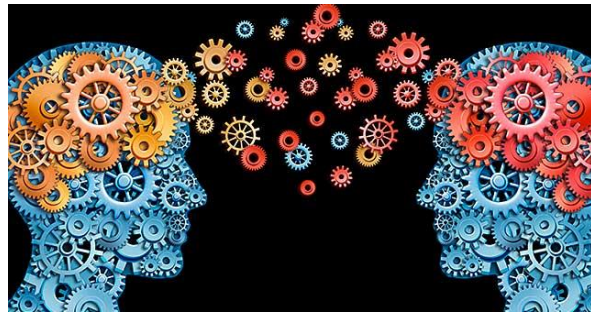


Knowledge Translation: Questions asked and lessons learnt from Health Sciences
